THE POWER OF WELL BEING

The 'Power of Well Being' is the informal name given to a statutory power which enables local Councils to do anything which it considers likely to achieve the promotion or improvement of the economic, social or environmental well being of their area. This came into force in June 2008 and a Council must achieve a list of eligibility criteria before being able to exercise the power. The Town Clerk, Mrs Laura West has achieved the necessary qualification to fulfil the criteria as prescribed in the Parish Councils (Power to Promote Well-Being) (Prescribed Conditions) Order 2008 and the Town Councillors are currently undergoing their training.

Outdoor Gym Equipment

Heanor Town Councillors Bob Janes and Ken Armstrong have, on behalf of the Town Council, successfully achieved funding from Derbyshire County Council's Communities Priorities Programme, to erect an Older Person's Playground on ground adjacent to Heanor Welfare Centre on Wilmot Street, Heanor.

The 'playground' consists of a variety of outdoor gym equipment. It has been sited adjacent to the single story Heanor Welfare Centre and existing children's play area and playing field.



Heanor and Loscoe Town Council are landlords of the Welfare Centre and already many of the Centre user groups are venturing out to use the new equipment. The Town Council are very excited about the equipment and its potential for encouraging social interaction whilst tackling the problems of obesity and inadequate physical activity, and providing a facility for rehabilitation following injury/illness.



Mr Terry Whittaker, Chairman of Heanor 50+ Forum and member of Derbyshire Older Peoples Advisory Group (DOPAG), is a regular user of the new facility and very enthusiastic about the equipment. Mr Whittaker said "The new gym equipment is a fantastic free facility, I use it on a regular basis to help maintain my fitness as a Football Association referee.

Sherwood Foresters Western Front Memorial

In the Autumn of 2008 the Town Council gave a small financial contribution toward the provision of a war memorial to over 11,000 men of the Sherwood Foresters regiment who died on the Western Front between 1914 and 1918. The official unveiling of the memorial took place on Saturday 24th October 2009 at the Tyne Cott Commonwealth War Graves Commission Cemetery near Ypres. Town Mayor Bob Janes and his consort Jenny Janes were delighted to be invited to attend the ceremony and lay a wreath on behalf of the Town Council.
