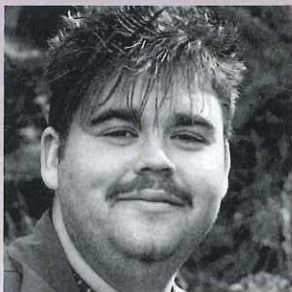
Quality Council Status

WW1 Commemoration 1914 - 2014

Reverend Dan Pattimore led a commemorative service held at St. Lawrence's Church, Heanor at 3pm on Sunday 3rd August 2014. Heanor History Society provided a display of World War One memorabilia. St. Lawrence's Church provided refreshments funded by the Town Council. Members of the Town Council read out the Roll of Honour and a group of Local Army Cadets did a reading. Framed medals and citation of Sgt. Wm. Gregg were on display and these will be placed in the Town Hall.

In the process of organising this event it became evident that there are two names missing from the War Memorial and a couple of amendments necessary to existing names. Amber Valley Borough Council has agreed to carry out this work.
