A WORD FROM THE MAYOR - COUNCILLOR PAUL JONES

Since our last Newsletter the Town Council has agreed its budget for the next year, which will allow us to continue to provide grants to many of the local community groups that play such an important role in our Town.

The other good news is that the Old Fire Station has been fully refurbished and will be opened as a Centre for Arts and Heritage, hopefully, in time for our Annual May Day Event taking place on May 7th. I am sure you will be very pleased with what has happened and that it will become a popular venue for you all, whether visiting the artefacts displayed by the Local History Society or exhibitions/events held by other community groups.

The Council is still in negotiations with the Borough Council regarding Wilmot Street Centre we intend to develop this as a community facility.

These are just a few examples of how the Council are committed to supporting our local community.

At its last meeting before the local elections the Council expressed concern about the proposal by Royal Mail to relocate their Sorting Office from Mansfield Road, Heanor to Ilkeston. The Town Council have written to Royal Mail requesting a meeting with a view to getting the decision reversed. Judy Mailaber MP, has supported the Council in this and is seeking an explanation from Royal Mail. Your local Borough Councillors have also supported the Councils opposition to the move and Amber Valley Borough Council has agreed to write to Royal Mail opposing their decision. I have personally visited the Sorting Office, and offered our support to the workforce.

Finally, I have recently chaired a meeting of NOTTCHH (No To The Closure of Heanor Hospital) action group that

continues to meet on behalf of the Town to find a solution to the closure of the minor injuries unit at the hospital. NOTTCHH have written to the Primary Care Trust, who run the hospital, putting some suggestion to them about how to move things forward.
